# Class Overview

## Course Requirements

Students must complete all assignments at a passing level. Complete a photo portfolio. Participate in clean-up and take all exams.

## Standards

Digital Photography is a project-based class in which the standards have been embedded into all the assignments and exams. In order to successfully complete the minimum requirements for this course, you will need to complete all assignment with a minimum score of a 3 on a 5 scale rubric.

## Late Work

Only work turned in on time will receive full credit. Make-up and late work will be accepted but at a reduced grade. The teacher will determine whether the assignments are late.

## Homework

For the most part, students will be taking pictures after/outside of school. However, there are times when a student has to take pictures during class time (This needs prior approval and arrangement). In addition, there may be assignments that require looking at magazine ads, watching television or completing worksheets.

## Participation

Classroom participation and proper behavior are essentials for student success. Every student is required to work and demonstrate proper classroom demeanor.

## Grades

Photographic assignments are graded on a double 5-scale rubric.  
Quizzes and written assignments are based on a 100 point scale.  
Homework and evaluations are based on a 5 point scale.  
Participation and assignment completeness are judged on a 20 point scale.

Everything is weighted and converted to a percentage. The grading scale is as followed:

B	78%	-	88%
C	65%	-	77%
F	64%	&	Below

## Portfolio

Students will maintain a graded portfolio of all work.
