

TPHS Discipline Policy Notification
2014-2015

The Torrey Pines High School Discipline Policy is written to comply with both SDUHSD Board Policy and State Education Code to ensure a safe and orderly learning environment. Please take a moment to access the policy online to ensure that you and your student know the school rules and possible disciplinary actions. Key items to be aware of:

- Torrey Pines High School is a closed campus to all Freshmen and Sophomores. Juniors and seniors are permitted to leave campus during lunch break, but **all students must remain on campus during nutrition break.**
- According to CA Education Code 48205, students are considered truant on their third unexcused tardy and/or their third unexcused absence. Unless an absence is cleared by a parent note, email or phone call within three (3) school days, the absence will be recorded as a truancy. **No changes can be made after three (3) school days.** Appropriate attendance interventions will be implemented for any student considered to have excessive absences, whether truant or excused, so please read the [SDUHSD policy regarding excused absences.](#)
- All students must have an Off-Campus Pass if leaving campus at any time, including leaving campus at lunch if they do not plan to attend their afternoon class. Off Campus Passes can be picked up in the attendance office. - Students are required to have a school issued written pass to leave classrooms during class hours.
- Students must be in class when the final bell rings or they are considered tardy. Students must have a written pass from a staff member, attendance office or an administrator for the teacher to excuse the tardy. Please read the [TPHS Discipline Policy](#) for more information.
- Academic honesty is a critical component of high school success. Students in violation of the SDUHSD Academic Honesty Policy are subject to disciplinary action. Violations include but are not limited to: copying homework, sending and/or receiving assignment information, or discussion of test questions. Please read the [SDUHSD BP 5144 AR-1](#) for more information.
- Students are expected to exercise good judgment, safety, good taste, and modesty regarding their dress and grooming. Any clothing considered to be disruptive to the educational process is inappropriate for school. Please read the [TPHS Discipline Policy](#) for more information.
- California law holds parents/guardians liable for any willful student misconduct which results in any injury to persons, defacement and/or loss of property belonging to the district or to a school employee. For more info, please review [SDUHSD BP5131.](#)
- Inappropriate use of electronic devices may result in confiscation and disciplinary action. All devices are the sole responsibility of the student and **SDUHSD is not responsible for lost or stolen items.**
- Suspensions of two (2) calendar days or more are accompanied with a 30-day extracurricular activity suspension. This includes suspension from participating in team sports.
