Rank: TPHS does not rank students. Simply put “None” on your Common Application and/or “N/A” for Non Common Application schools.

CSSID or SSID number: This is located on your Aeries account and called your “State Stu ID” or on the bottom of your transcript and called your “State ID #”

What GPA do I use?: For the UC’s and CSU’s you will use your 10-12 academic weighted GPA

For all other universities you will use your 9-12 total weighted GPA

How are school materials (transcript, recommendations) submitted?

**Common App** – transcripts and recommendations will be sent through Naviance by your counselor.

**UC’s and CSU’s** – do not accept transcripts or recommendations, self- report on application.

**Non-Common App** – as long as the college accepts electronic submissions (DocuFide), all school materials (transcript, recommendations) will be sent through Naviance. If your college does not accept electronic submissions, please see your counselor.

Sending test scores:

**SAT scores can be requested to be sent to college/Universities through [www.collegeboard.com](http://www.collegeboard.com)**

**ACT scores can be requested to be sent to colleges/Universities through [ACT.org](http://ACT.org)**

UC- Send ACT/SAT scores to one UC campus, and they will automatically be sent to all campuses you apply to (Save money, do not send scores to all campuses!).

CSU- Send ACT/SAT scores to one CSU campus, and they will automatically be sent to all campuses you apply to.

Private/Out of State Colleges - Send ACT and SAT scores to each individual college/University.
