The goal of the FalconFest is to build community, reduce stress and to help end the teasing, harassment and alienation that can be a part of the high school experience. FalconFest is a powerful and transformational day that can change the way people view each other forever. It is a day of fun, friendship, and new possibilities. FalconFest is for all grade levels, but we especially encourage 9th and 10th graders to participate in order to enjoy the lasting connections, benefits and learning that will stay with them throughout their high school experience.

Please note: Administration and Staff encourages student attendance and will not penalize students for the missed day of class.
