

Independent Study On Line (ISOL) Tips for Success

Please read and use these tips to make a plan and complete your course!

- 1) To Log in: Go to start.sduhsd.net and click on *Edgenuity Help* > *Link to Edgenuity (Student Site)* then enter User Name: SmithJ1234 LastnameFirstInitiallast4digits Password: ID Number
- 2) You can also find the Edgenuity website at <https://learn.education2020.com/> and use same user/password
- 3) Watch the Orientation Video
 - Click *Organizer* > *Resources* > *Student Orientation Video*
- 4) Work on your ISOL class on a regular schedule. Make a PLAN and KEEP IT!
 - Follow Your Assignment Calendar
 - Click *Organizer* > *Reports* > *Assignment Calendar*
 - Complete the assignments as listed each day
 - **If you get behind, you may use the weekends/holidays to catch up**
 - Get ahead if you can
 - Come to Room 9 every class period and work UNTIL you complete your ISOL course and then you don't have to come anymore!
 - PLAN: KNOW WHEN, WHERE AND HOW LONG you are going to work each day
- 5) Monitor your Progress Report regularly – it shows the number of units and quizzes to help you plan!
 - Click *Organizer* > *Reports* > *Progress Report*
- 6) When you are watching your lesson videos, use the lesson pane: take e-notes, review the glossary, and read the transcript
- 7) If you fail a quiz, STUDY before taking it a second time
 - Re-watch the lesson video and/or read the video transcript. Find the answers to the questions you missed
 - Review vocabulary – you may use the glossary in your lesson pane
 - If you still do not understand the lesson, you may use Google to find more information. However, you may NOT use Google or any additional resource on the topic unit test.
 - Remember, you may use enotes, the glossary, and look up information on quizzes only
 - Let me know if you are struggling!
- 8) Prepare for the topic test/ unit test
 - Review the topic test review AND quizzes. You will see familiar questions from both the quizzes and topic test review on the topic test.
 - Review vocabulary words, and be sure to look up items you missed
- 9) **FINISH YOUR ISOL COURSE EARLY! ALL TPHS ISOL COURSES end at 9 am on the last Friday before Finals Week. Every course must be 100% complete by end of semester to earn a grade or the final grade is an F.**
