CAASPP Results Show Significant Gains

The California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) results are in and TPHS demonstrated significant gains in 2017-2018. TPHS is up 16.5% in English and 12.5% in math compared to 2016-2017. Our increases were among all demographic groups are higher than similar schools in the county. Given the typical goal is a 1%-3% increase, our recent success is very exciting. CAASPP results give us a measure of student performance in math and English, and help us gauge our students' ability to write clearly, think critically and solve problems. As we head into our annual spring testing season, we hope all Falcon families are inspired by these positive results to do even better this year! CDE Dashboard

Our CAASPP results are only part of the accountability picture. As part of [ESSA](#), the California Department of Education (CDE) has created an accountability Dashboard to help schools and communities better understand how they are serving students. The Dashboard tracks test scores, discipline, graduation rates, and college/career readiness for all students and breaks down results so we can better target our resources. College & Career Readiness (CCR)

The CDE has designated several key areas as data points to ensure our students are ready for college and beyond. Our [TPHS CCR](#) data includes CAASPP results, AP exam results, CTE completers, UC A-G completion rates and dual enrollment with community colleges. It's not just about spring tests anymore. The [CCR](#) is a more comprehensive way for us to look at how we serve the unique needs of our students.

Did You Know?

We hope all of our Falcons take their education seriously, including our spring testing. As added incentive, it's good to know that colleges are using CAASPP results as a placement guide for college math and English, and scores can be reviewed as part of an application.
