General Information

Description

In this year long course, students will build on concepts studied in Teaching and Learning I going into more depth and complexity. A portion of the class time will be spent practicing teaching and professional skills in an actual elementary school setting. Students apply concepts, analyze real life situations, and reflect on their own teaching practice. Students will expand and gain more experience in the classroom and in a real world professional setting working with children. Critical analysis of selected topics including: leadership and teaching styles, developmental psychology and implications for education, student guidance and classroom management, conflict resolutions and peer mediation, principles of teaching and learning, educational strategies, curriculum development, and special populations.

Expectations and Goals

Students should expect the following from the course:

- Prerequisite: Teaching and Learning I
- Students need their own transportation during 4th or 5th period.
- Visit local elementary schools twice a week and work in the same classroom for the year.
- Build a strong professional relationship with elementary school teacher.
- Assist in teaching lessons, planning lessons, reading with students, grading papers, creating bulletin boards, assisting in STEAM, art, and PE, and any other duties the classroom teacher supervises.
- Gain valuable and hands-on experience with school-age children.
- Be a strong role model to young children.
- Learn from professionals in the field of education during guest speaker presentations.
- Learn college programs and options for students to further their education working with children.
