ELD 3 is a course designed to continue English language development as well as to introduce students to mainstream literature and grade level language arts common core standards. The course focuses on vocabulary expansion, grammar and sentence structure, paragraph structure, essay formatting, reading comprehension, and literary analysis. EDGE level B, designed for English language learners at the intermediate level, is the textbook used. In addition, the following novels are read throughout the year: Seedfolks by Paul Fleishman, The Pearl by John Steinbeck, and The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Nighttime by Mark Haddon. Poetry, essays, and short stories connected to the curriculum are also used. (College Prep)
