

**Torrey Pines HIGH SCHOOL  
CAL GRANT “OPT-OUT” FORM  
SENIORS ONLY**

With the implementation of Assembly Bill 2160, California public high schools are required to submit a Cal Grant high school Grade Point Average (GPA) for all graduating seniors, unless the student or parent has opted-out of the submission process.

Cal Grant gives funds to every eligible senior student who meets the requirement. A Cal Grant pays for tuition, room and board, or books and other supplies for California colleges. Cal Grant applicants must also file the FAFSA or the California Dream Act application between October 1, 2018 and March 1, 2019.

If you **DO NOT** wish to have your student’s information submitted electronically, you must complete the opt-out information below and return to:

**This form must be returned no later than September 24, 2018.** After that date, the information for all seniors, excluding those who opt-out, will be submitted electronically to the California Student Aid Commission for Cal Grant consideration.
